### “KAKEHASHI” FRP CORE WOOD BATHTUBS



■ Japanese OFURO (wooden soaking bathtubs) most appreciated features are:

- HEALTH: soaking in hot water is beneficial to blood circulation and to detox the body, neutralize oxidizing ions..
- WELLBEING: the wood is not sealed, therefore the hot water draws out the fragrant and relaxing essential oils
- DESIGN: the minimalist shape built with attention for the details makes it for a protagonist in the bath area.
- FLEXIBILITY: “kakehashi” are highly customizable and suitable for boats, dry environments etc. without risk of leaks

#### ■ Technology

With the "KAKEHASHI" technique it is possible to make any convex curve and even concave shapes! The curved walls can be straight or even slanted in and out, free as a freehand sketch. The "KAKEHASHI" tubs do not have exposed metal and the look is very organic and natural.

It is possible to create triangular tubs, flower shaped, fan shaped, eggplant shaped tubs, etc. "KAKEHASHI" tubs are made with thin but solid (not engineered) hinoki wood.

They have the advantage of a superior resistance to dryness and are leak proof. They can be equipped with a pneumatic controlled popup drain and overflow system concealed inside the walls.
